
We kindly invite you to the opening of the exhibition 31 years of shame in the company of the erased and Amnesty International Slovenia (AIS), which will take place on Friday, 7 April 2023, at 7 p.m. in artKIT.

On 26 February 1992, after the erasure from the permanent population register, 25,671 people were left overnight without a legal status, without valid documents, without rights. The consequences were merciless: they were left without jobs, without the possibility of education, without access to a doctor, without social assistance, thousands were deported from Slovenia, etc. The exhibition is a tribute to the courage and unwavering perseverance of the erased, who rose from the darkness and pain of loneliness, united and organised themselves into a movement, into a resistance, into a multi-year campaign. They collectivised

themselves and civil society and created the strongest, most long-lasting and enduring movement we know.

We dedicate this exhibition to Aleksandar Todorović, an untiring fighter for redress for the erased.
